



HKAC Foreign License Holders Update

Effective 1st January 2009 Foreign License holders will not be able to fly Hong Kong registered aircraft in Hong Kong, unless you hold a Certificate of Validation (C of V) issued by the CAD.

To be able to apply for this Certificate of Validation you will be required to:

- 1. Undergo a flight test with a HKAC Authorized Examiner, which will be similar to the GFT.**
- 2. Complete a ground exam, which will be conducted by the Authorized Examiner.**

This C of V will be valid for 12 months and is renewable.

Some club members, who are self-authorized pilots, are eligible for a one off grant of a 6 month C of V, which will be valid until mid 2009. Flight operations will be handling the application for these 6 months C of V on your behalf but they will be contacting you for details. To be eligible for this one off C of V you require the following:

- 1. Be a HKAC self-authorized pilot.**
- 2. Have carried out a check flight with a HKAC Instructor within the last 12 months.**
- 3. Have a current Foreign License & Medical Certificate.**
