1	<p>Ronco Franciacorta Brut DOCG Grape Varieties : Chardonnay 70%, Pinot blanc 20%, Pinot noir 10% Color: Light straw yellow with greenish shades. Nose: Ripe fruit (anasas, peach and pear), white flowers, citrus fruit, magnolia, lime tree and biscuit bread. Palate: Expressive structure and well-orchestrated, acidity balance to the important structure. Persistent and long after-taste.</p>	NV	Italy	Sparkling
2	<p>Anselmi Prosecco Spumante Aromatico Grape Varieties: 100% Prosecco Color: Straw yellow, with a fine perlage. Nose: Lightly aromatic nose of good intensity with hints of rennet apple. Palate: Very soft mouthfeel inderpinned by zesty acidity. An easy-drinking wine.</p>	NV	Italy	Sparkling
3	<p>Anselmi Muller Thurgau IGT Superiore Grape Variety: 100% Muller Thurgau Color: Straw yellow with green tinges. Nose: Floral bouquet with notes of ripe fruit. Has a characteristic freshness. Palate: Fresh, well-balanced, with a soft, full-bodied mouthfeel.</p>	2008	Italy	White
4	<p>Anselmi Bianco di Bianco IGT Superiore Grape Varieties: 40% Chardonnay, 60% Pinot Grigio Color: Varying deep straw yellow with greenish hues. Nose: Complex, subtly fruity bouquet, delicately aromatic. Palate: Dry yet always elegant and satisfying mouthfeel.</p>	2008	Italy	White
5	<p>Anselmi Riesling IGT Superiore Grape Variety: 100% Riesling Renano Color: Straw yellow with greenish tinges. Nose: Scented, fresh, flowery. Palate: Lemony, dry.</p>	2008	Italy	White
6	<p>Montaribaldi Barbaresco Sori Montaribaldi DOCG Grape Varieties: 100 % Nebbiolo Color: Ruby-red with garnet-red tints. Nose: Great and rich as only the nebbiolo vine can express. The viola and the rose blend well with the scents of plum, cocoa, tobacco, clove and black pepper. Palate: Austere tannins of big power fill the mouth, nevertheless without causing bitter sensations or setting teeth on edge. On the contrary, the tannin, together with alcohol,gives sweet and velvet sensations. The ending is long with sensations reminding of berry-fruit jam.</p>	2004	Italy	Red
7	<p>Cyan 12 Meses Barrica Grape Variety: 100% Tinta de Toro RP: 90 Color: Black cherry, well covered. Nose: Very intense, smell of dark fruit, spices, liquorice, high roast, and mentholated. Palate: Very concentrated, powerful, large, with ripe and rounded tannin, with black fruit and mentholated.</p>	2003	Spain	Red
8	<p>Matarronera Crianza Grape Variety: 100% Tempranillo Color: Dark, clean and bright. Nose: Round, intense and complex in aromas, with a dominance of vanilla, leather, tobacco and liquorice. Palate: Elegant and harmonious, with a lingering finish.</p>	2006	Spain	Red
9	<p>Chateau Marjosse (<i>Cheval Blanc and Yquem's winemaker, Pierre Lurton</i>) Grape Varieties: Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon Color: Garnet red tending towards purple Nose: Plum, Indian spice and fresh herb character Palate: It is a delicious, up-front, fruity, silky-textured, medium-bodied Bordeaux possessing plenty of red and black currant fruit as well as notions of wood spice and earth.</p>	2006	France	Red
10	<p>Château Fatin (<i>From the owner of Leoville Poyferre - 2nd Growth</i>) Grape Varieties: Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon Color: Dark with soft purple shades and a predominance of red colours. Nose: Aromas of a fresh rubber, bramble berries and fresh forward fruit on the nose. Palate: This wine has a tight palate with earthy hints and flavors and textures of red delicious apple skins. Hints of black pepper and spice on the finish.</p>	2000	France	Red
11	<p>Anselmi Moscato Rosa IGT Superiore Grape Varieties: 100% Moscato Rosa Color: Varies from ruby to garnet with amber tinges. Nose: Displays an attractive, aromatic, spicy perfume redolent of rose along with the aromas of red berries. Palate: Subtle, aromatic flavour, fresh and elegant, with notes of strawberry and floral taste.</p>	2009	Italy	Sweet Rose
